




Multi-Member Ward Overall COVID Vulnerability Spectrum

100 = Most Vulnerable MMW in Aberdeenshire









Multi-Member Ward Age Vulnerability Spectrum





Summary

The Intermediate Zones within this Ward are among the less vulnerable in Aberdeenshire, according to the age vulnerability indicators. The proportion of people aged 65+ ranges from 10.1% in Banchory-Devenick and Findon to 18.6% in Newtonhill and all are below the average for Aberdeenshire.

Only the Portlethen IZ has an above average proportion of over 65's in receipt of Attendance Allowance payments (10.4% against an average of 8.2%). The rest range from the third lowest in Aberdeenshire at 3.9% - Dunecht, Durris and Drumoak to 7.9%





Multi-Member Ward Economic Vulnerability Spectrum


