Hello,

During 2015/2016, a group of volunteers set up a temporary headquarters in the then British Legion in Inverurie to assist those who had been affected by flooding in Inverurie and Port Elphinstone.

Since then we have been working with residents, Inverurie Community Council, and Scottish Flood Forum to formally set up a plan, involving volunteers and local groups in the event of flooding, severe weather, utility failure, major fire and medical epidemic in our area. There will be a copy for you to view in Inverurie Library, soon. We will also have the plan online, for all to view at a future date.

Community Resilience is an initiative supported by local, Scottish, and the UK Governments. The principal is that communities develop a local plan so that they can help themselves during an emergency in a way that compliments, but in no way replaces, the response of the emergency responders.

Because you may have received, or know of someone who has received help from us before during flooding, we would like to ask you if you would be willing to help our local, Garioch Resilience Group?

We are recruiting volunteers.

We have attached a 'Questionnaire for Volunteers'. We would like you to join us, by completing and returning to us the Questionnaire by scanning and emailing to 'gariochresiliencegroup@gmail.com, or by post to our colleagues at 'The Garioch Partnership, or you can hand it into Inverurie Library.

We have also attached a Policy Notice, to keep, to inform you on how we are planning on using your information once submitted, and how you can inform us if you no longer wish to be involved.

We have also included a 'Household Emergency Plan', for you to keep. Once completed this will be a useful guide for you to keep safe, on how you can prepare yourself, family and property in the event of an emergency.

We look forward to receiving the Questionnaire for Volunteers, back from you soon.
