- Pensions
- Repairs and maintenance –
 - (a) information relating to addresses and occupancy will be shared with our sub-contractors and consultants engaged to assess tenant satisfaction with repairs;
 - (b) Temperature, Humidity and Address data relating to, and collected by, any environmental sensors fitted within the home to assist with damp condensation and mould investigations, will be shared with our contractor. Aberdeenshire Council will access and analysis the information via a web-based 'dashboard';
 - (c) information relating to address and occupancy, and some personal data, may be shared with our contractor when previous repairs and maintenance data is sent to them to be processed by their software. This allows Aberdeenshire Council to access and analysis information, on a web-based 'dashboard', that specifically relates to damp, condensation, and mould issues
- New build properties
 - (a) Information relating to contact details for access to properties will be shared with the Main Contractor and their sub-contractors after practical completion of works and during the relevant defects period.
 - (b) Information relating to contact details for access to properties will be shared with the Main Contractor and their sub-contractors after the relevant defects period (i) in the event of any latent defects being discovered or (ii) access could not be achieved during the relevant defects period.
- Refurbishments and upgrades –
 - (a) information relating to addresses and occupancy will be shared with our sub-contractors and consultants engaged to assess tenant satisfaction with refurbishments and upgrades;
 - (b) information relating to addresses and occupancy will be shared with our contractors;
 - (c) addresses and energy generation and export data will be shared with our contractor to allow the registering and monitoring of solar PV panels and associated equipment. This allows Aberdeenshire Council to access and analysis information, on a web-based 'dashboard'
- O/T assessments – information relating to addresses and occupancy will be shared with our contractors
- Estate Management – depending on the issues we may share information with our Community Safety Partners including Police, NHS etc.
