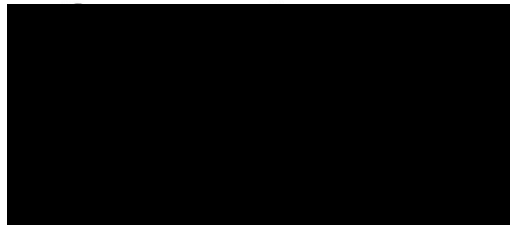
**Independent examiner's statement**
