









General Health / COVID Proxy Health Indicators



Most health-related indicators suggest the general population within the Ward is relatively healthy. However, the additional Covid deaths since the previous iteration of the CIA report, particularly in Durno-Chapel of Garioch, negatively impacted the area's overall health ranking this time round. IZs associated with this Ward recorded 16 COVID-related deaths between March 1st and June 30th 2021, an increase of 10 deaths since the previous report (4 more in both Durno-Chapel of Garioch and Insch, Oyne and Ythanwells, and 1 more in both Kemnay and Howe of Alford). The location of a care home or hospital may have effected this outcome. (Aberdeenshire recorded a total of 253 COVID-related deaths between March 1st and June 30th 2021, an increase of 136 since the previous report.)

Howe of Alford and Kemnay both appear to have dropped down the rankings in respect of the proportion of Households in receipt of Universal Credit with Limited Work Capability and the rate of PIP payments relative to their respective 16+ population.


Indeed, benefits related to disability (PIP payments) are on the rise throughout the Ward and hundreds of additional households receive Universal Credit compared to at the beginning of the pandemic. However, the rate of PIP payments is comparatively low in an Aberdeenshire context.




% of UC Households where at least 1 occupant has limited work capability
