## **General Health / COVID Proxy Health Indicators**









Most pre-Covid health-related indicators suggest the general population within the Ward is relatively healthy. Indeed, this Ward has one of the best health ranking in Aberdeenshire. IZs associated with this Ward recorded 17 Covid-related deaths between March 1<sup>st</sup> and June 30<sup>th</sup> 2021, an increase of 4 deaths since the previous report (2 more in Westhill North and South, and 1 more in both Dunecht, etc., and Howe of Alford). Garlogie and Elrick is 1 of just 5 IZs in Aberdeenshire to record zero deaths since the pandemic began. (Aberdeenshire recorded a total of 253 COVID-related deaths between March 1st and June 30th 2021, an increase of 136 since the previous report.)


In the context of the Ward, Westhill North & Southarquably has the worst health profile with regards to the pre-Covid health indicators. Some of the more up-to-date indicators, such as PIP payments, suggest Howe of Alford may also rank highly in this regard.

Indeed, benefits related to disability (PIP payments) are on the rise throughout the Ward and hundreds of additional households receive Universal Credit compared to at the beginning of the pandemic. However, the rate of PIP payments remains comparatively low in an Aberdeenshire context despite the rise in numbers. (They are rising in most other IZs.)
